



Lean Plant Assessment Course

The AICCC is offering packaging professionals an 8 hour training course offered over two days on Lean Plant Assessment. The course will give an overview of 11 categories of Lean production of goods and services. This tool is an objective standard where you will receive a clear understanding of the theory, some background on Lean Manufacturing and practical experience in measuring a plant's 11 categories of operations with 200 characteristics of manufacturing on Lean Standards.

Participants will learn to rate any plant (their own or a supplier's) and to use the results to target increased speed and accuracy of information and material flow. Use limited resources for maximum impact using the Lean Plant Assessment results as a guide. This is a valuable diagnostic tool that allows you to focus your limited time, money and resources on the area of greatest return in productivity and profits. This training is based on tools developed at the University of Michigan School of Business called the "Rapid Plant Assessment". Participants will receive training using this the tool enabling them to apply the processes and standards in their own plant

Presented by: Scott Ellis and Scott Heilmann of PSquared. PSquared is a multi-disciplined improvement team with expertise in engineering, business management, and organizational psychology. Their approach is to address the policies, procedures and personalities that support the organization. They assess, train, coach, manage, measure and build in accountability systems to ensure that administrative and production best practices endure. The course is designed to covers the 11 Characteristics of an effective manufacturing plant.
