Why You Can't Do A Two Minute Changeover (and why some can)!

- Methods of Japanese and American crews doing 30 plus changeovers per day
- Synchronized movement of tooling, material, and information
- No need for a schedule at the machine

Session Three is designed for Production leaders who deal with industry pressure to manage two and three times the historic number of changeovers. Modern equipment is designed to enable minimal changeover time. They are unable to do so because they are normally being supplied through antiquated methods that are slow, inaccurate, and costly. Examples will show how to provide synchronized supply to the process with order sizes dipping below 1000 pieces and the number of set ups per day reaching toward 50.
